

On the 26<sup>th</sup>, 27<sup>th</sup>, 28<sup>th</sup> and 29<sup>th</sup> of July Cadiz will be host to the 50<sup>th</sup> Anniversary Tall Ships Race organised by Sail Training International, to commemorate fifty years since the celebration of the first Tall Ships Race in 1956.

This is a great opportunity to meet people from other countries and experience the unique sensation of participating in the organisation of a great nautical event. The regatta will be similar to those celebrated in Cadiz in 1992 and 2000 and will allow us to show the city to all the visitors who will come to the event.

For this reason the 2006 Municipal Regatta Committee would like to make an appeal to the citizens of Cadiz to participate in the 50<sup>th</sup> Anniversary Tall Ships Race as volunteers. The work of a volunteer in a sporting event of this size is fundamental to its organisation and successful execution. Volunteers will be assigned to all areas of the event such as: protocol, the press office, the tourist office, the race office, Civil Protection, transport, sporting activities etc...

**THE CONDITIONS REQUIRED TO JOIN THE VOLUNTEER PROGRAMME OF THE 50<sup>th</sup> ANNIVERSARY TALL SHIPS RACE. (25<sup>th</sup> – 29<sup>th</sup> of JULY 2006)**

**WHAT IT TAKES TO BE A VOLUNTEER:**

- Personal Commitment.
- Participate actively and directly in society.
- Undertake work without remuneration.
- Be conscious of the social value of your actions.
- Work in a team with a common objective.

**VOLUNTEER'S RIGHTS:**

- To be informed of the characteristics of the programmes in which you will take part and the activities involved.
- Receive training and information as well as the means to undertake the activity.
- Participate in the running, evaluation and design of the activities.
- To cease to be a volunteer.
- To be insured against accidents and illness as well as third party civil responsibility insurance, derived from volunteer activity and in accordance with the established regulations.
- To be correctly identifiable as a volunteers.
- To receive a certificate authenticating the work undertaken.

**VOLUNTEERS OBLIGATIONS:**

- Fulfill the commitment acquired with the organising body as well as with its regulations.
- Collaborate in the consecution of the programmes objectives.
- To maintain information received while carrying out their work confidential.
- Follow the technical instructions given for the correct running of the activity.
- Respect the people you are in contact with as a volunteer as well as the materials you are given to undertake the activity.
- Training: It is the volunteer's responsibility to be trained to carry out their work responsibly and efficiently.

### REQUIREMENTS FOR BEING A VOLUNTEER IN THE 50TH ANNIVERSARY TALL SHIPS RACE:

- Anybody over the age of 18 who wishes to participate in the organisation of the 50<sup>th</sup> Anniversary Tall Ships Race voluntarily.
- Anybody between the ages of 16 and 18, with the authorisation of their parents. (Decree 55/2004, 17<sup>th</sup> of February of the Andalusian Sporting Volunteers Programme).
- To be resident in Cadiz during the duration of the regatta. The organisation does not cover volunteer's travel and accommodation expenses etc.
- Participate in the training courses offered by the organisation.
- To be available between the 15<sup>th</sup> and 30<sup>th</sup> of July.

### VOLUNTEER SELECTION:

The selection of the volunteers that will participate in the 50<sup>th</sup> Anniversary Tall Ships Race will be carried out by the technical group of the Youth Department and the Municipal Regatta Committee. This process will take place using the criteria established for participation, the adequacy of the candidate for any of the different areas and in the participation of the training courses offered by the organisation.

### PARTICIPATION UNDERTAKING:

Incorporation into the volunteer programme should be formalised in writing. This written commitment as well as including the characteristics of the volunteers mission as established in article 3 of the Volunteer's law 7/2001. (12<sup>th</sup> of July), should include the following:

- The rights and duties of both parties as set out in the present law.
- The type of work and activities that the volunteer will undertake, and the time that will be dedicated to this task.
- The training required to undertake these activities and the process to be followed to obtain it.
- The duration of the agreement and the causes and ways that the agreement can be dissolved.

#### HOW TO LOSE THE CONDITION OF BEING A VOLUNTEER:

One can cease to be a volunteer for the following reasons:

- With prior warning at the petition of the volunteer.
- By declaring his/hers incapacity for natural reasons that impedes the carrying out of the volunteers actions.
- To not comply with the necessary requirements.
- For unjustifiably breaking the agreement.
- For not complying with or for a serious infraction of the Volunteers Law.

(Civil Protection volunteers will be regulated by the specific conditions contemplated in the Law 2/1985, 21<sup>st</sup> April.)

#### CLOSING DATE FOR INSCRIPTIONS:

- Until the 7<sup>th</sup> of March 2006.
